

# Self-Pay “Cash” Prices

## Base Fee for Urgent Care Consultations

1st Consultation with Provider	May include 1 of the following: Glucose fingerstick, Pregnancy Test, Urine Dip, Rapid Strep Throat Test, Ace Wrap	\$160
Follow Up Consultation for same condition	Must be within 2 weeks of 1st Consultation with Provider	\$100

## Add Ons

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Antigen Test	A method used to detect RSV by checking for specific proteins in the nose or throat. Results are ready during the visit.	\$35
Lacerations	A bundled fee of 3 visits.	\$320 to \$450
Ear Lavage	Otherwise known as an ear irrigation or ear flush. This is a safe procedure that uses liquid to remove earwax.	\$50 per ear
RPR (Rapid Plasma Reagin (RPR) Test)	This screening test is used to detect antibodies in the blood that indicate a syphilis infection. Syphilis is a sexually transmitted infection (STI) caused by the bacterium Treponema pallidum.	\$30
HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus)	Often considered to be a sexually transmitted disease.	\$45
Hepatitis B Titer	A hepatitis B titer is a blood test that measures the level of antibodies against the hepatitis B virus (HBV) in a person's blood. This test helps determine if a person is immune to hepatitis B and has received an adequate vaccination series.	\$40
Chlamydia (CT) / Neisseria Gonorrhoeae (GC)	Two commonly sexually transmitted infections caused by bacteria. Can be done by testing urine or swab.	\$175
Herpes 1 and 2 IgG Test	A blood test that detects antibodies produced by the body in response to the herpes simplex virus (HSV). The test can help determine if you've been infected with HSV-1 or HSV-2 in the past.	\$150

Pre-Operative Exam	Typically includes a patient's medical history review and the physical examination. Other tests depend on the surgery type and the health condition of the patient. Other tests (with additional fees) could include a blood test, urine test, and/or imaging like an EKG or chest X-ray.	\$160
Sports Physical Exam	You are welcome to bring in your school's form or we can also provide.	\$95
